Day 00: Delhi to Manali | Overnight Volvo

- Today, you will board a Volvo bus from Delhi to Kullu Manali after 7 PM.
- It's an overnight journey, so please ensure you're well prepared for the trip.

Day 1: Arrival and Acclimatization in Kullu Manali

- Arrive in Kullu Manali and check in at your pre-booked camps/hotel to settle in.
- Take the day to rest and acclimatise to the beautiful surroundings.
- Enjoy a leisurely stroll on your own cost to the enchanting Hadimba Temple, dedicated to Hadimba Devi, the legendary wife of Bhima from the Mahabharata, and marvel at its unique architecture nestled in the forest.
- Continue your exploration to Manu Temple, situated by the serene Beas River, honouring sage Manu, the creator of the world. (on your own cost)
- Get ready for an informative orientation process and tour briefing, setting the stage for the adventures ahead.
- Indulge in a delicious dinner before resting for the night in Kullu Manali, rejuvenating for the exciting days to come.





Day 02: Journey from Manali to Jispa / Sarchu

- Arrive in Manali and check in at your pre-booked camps/hotel to settle in.
- Take the day to rest and acclimatise to the beautiful surroundings by your own.
- Enjoy a leisurely stroll to the enchanting Hadimba Temple, dedicated to Hadimba Devi, the legendary wife of Bhima from the Mahabharata, and marvel at its unique architecture nestled in the forest.
- Continue your exploration to Manu Temple, situated by the serene Beas River, honouring sage Manu, the creator of the world.

Day 03: Journey from Jispa / Sarchu to Leh

- Gear up for an exciting adventure as you cross the 16,043-ft-high Baralacha La Pass in the Zaskar Range.
- Experience the thrill of riding through the rugged terrains of Darcha and Zingzingbar.
- Spend time near the Chandrabhaga River (Chenab) and capture mesmerising photos.
- Visit the stunning Suraj Taal and Deepak Taal, two breathtaking lakes in the Lahaul and Spiti regions.
- Upon reaching Sarchu, hand over your bike keys to the road captain.
- Upon arriving in Jispa/Sarchu, hand over your bike keys to the road captain.
- Check in at your accommodation for the night.
- Enjoy dinner, and a comfortable overnight stay in Jispa/Sarchu





Day 04: Journey from Jispa/Sarchu to Leh

- Start your day with a delicious breakfast.
- Begin your journey towards Leh, the hub of the Ladakh region.
- Travel through Nakeela Pass, Whisky Nallah, Lachulung La Pass, Pang, More Plains, and Tanglang La Pass.
- Upon arriving in Leh, hand over your bike keys to the road captain.
- Check in at your accommodation for the night.
- Enjoy dinner, and a comfortable overnight stay in Leh.





Day 05: Journey from Leh to Nubra Valley

- Wake up to a refreshing morning and start your day with a delicious breakfast.
- Enjoy an exhilarating bike ride as your engines roar through the stunning Nubra Valley, a cold desert filled with vast landscapes and majestic mountain ranges.
- Experience the thrill of crossing Khardung La, one of the World's Highest Motorable Passes.
- On your way to Nubra, take a moment to appreciate the beautiful Buddha Statue and Diskit Monastery.
- Upon reaching Nubra, you have the option to enjoy a camel ride in the sand dunes (additional cost applies).
- Later, hand over your bike keys to the road captain and settle in for an overnight stay in Nubra (Hunder).
- Enjoy dinner, and a comfortable overnight stay in Nubra Valley.





Day 06: Journey from Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso

- Start your day with a hearty breakfast to fuel your adventurous spirit.
- Prepare for another day of daring off-roading as you traverse untamed paths in the high mountains.
- Your route leads to the stunning Pangong Tso (lake) via the Shyok River or Wari La Pass—an exhilarating journey often used by the army.
- Upon arrival, feast your eyes on the enchanting blue lake and its breathtaking surroundings. (If the Agam route is closed, we'll adjust the itinerary accordingly.)
- Once you reach Pangong Tso, take your time to enjoy the picturesque lake and the magnificent views all around you.
- Later, hand over your bike keys to the road captain and settle in for an overnight stay.
- Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay at Pangong Tso, along with breakfast for the following day.





Day 07: Journey from Pangong to Hanle with Rezang La War Memorial

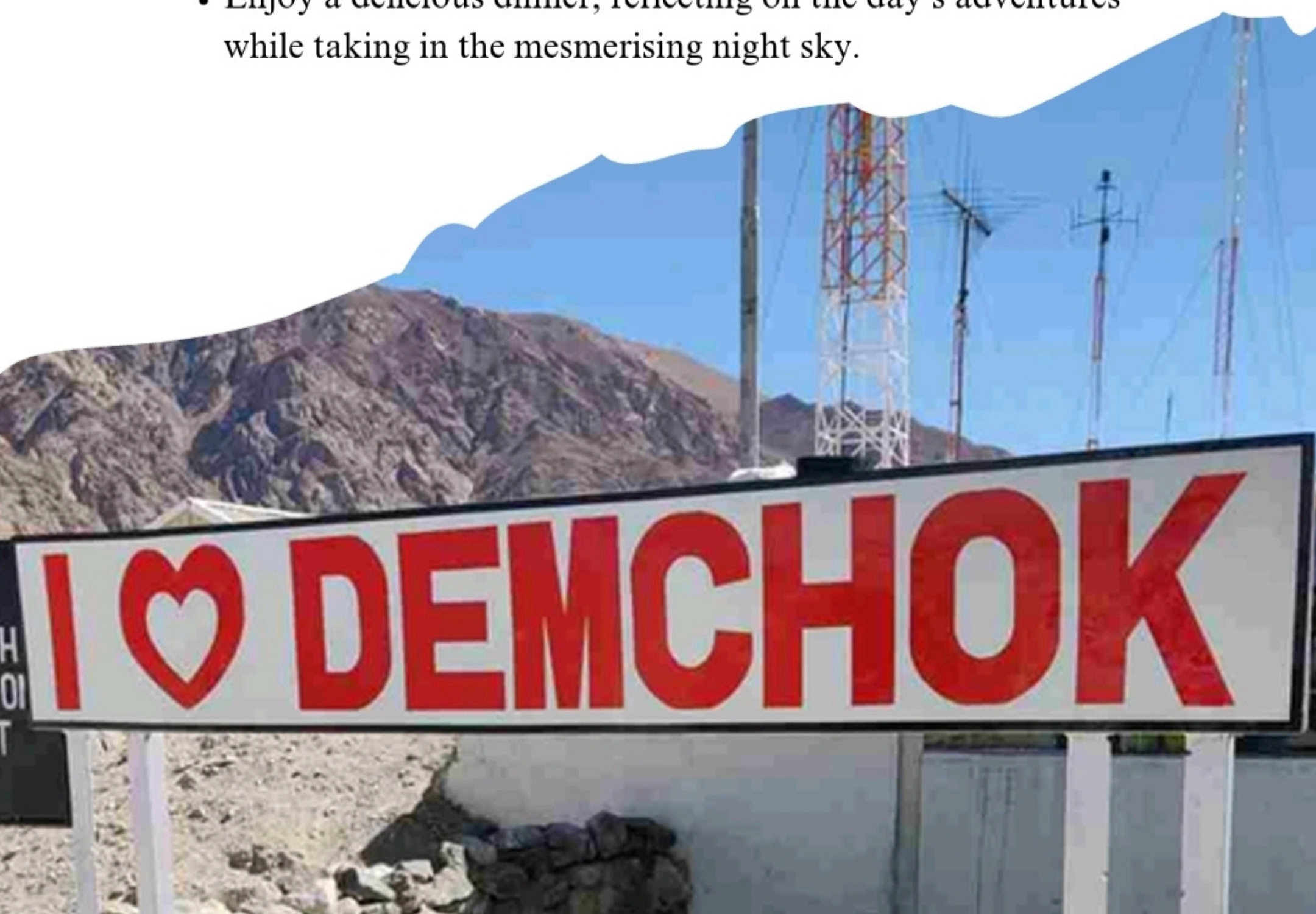
- Start your bike ride from Pangong Lake after having breakfast at your accommodation.
- Depart from Pangong, enjoying the stunning views as you ride.
- Reach Chushul and visit the Rezang La War Memorial, honouring the heroes of the 1962 Indo-China War.
- Enjoy views of the Black Mountain as you ride.
- Reach Hanle en route to Loma Bend.
- Visit the Hanle Observatory (if you arrive in Hanle before 4 PM).
- Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay while taking in the beauty of the night in Hanle.





Day 08: Journey from Hanle to Umling la, Demchok and Transfer to Tso Moriri

- Start the day with a hearty breakfast in Hanle, preparing for an exhilarating ride ahead.
- Set off toward Umling La Top, the highest motorable road in the world, where breathtaking views and adrenaline await.
- Weather permitting, venture to the enchanting Demchok Village, where you can marvel at the beautiful India-China River, a stunning natural border between the two nations.
- After soaking in the sights, return via the scenic View of Nyoma, with picturesque landscapes accompanying your ride.
- Start your journey towards Tso Moriri for an overnight stay.
- Enjoy a delicious dinner, reflecting on the day's adventures while taking in the mesmerising night sky.





Day 09: Journey from Tso Moriri to Sarchu

- Wake up to the beautiful views of Tso Moriri in the morning and have your breakfast.
- Get ready for an adventurous journey as we make our way to Sarchu.
- On the way, we will stop to explore the Puga Valley, home to several hot springs and mud pools, and known as a hub for generating geothermal energy.
- Continue the journey, until we reach Tso Kar for another quick stop.
- Here, we will witness the unique white landscape of salt deposit that is left behind by the saline water on the shores of the lake.
- After riding further we will reach the Manali-Leh road.
- On the way we will pass some major high-altitude passes like the Lachung-La (5065 m) and Nakee-La (4738 m).
- We will also soak in the stunning landscape at the famous Moore Plains, a straight and flattened road stretching over 50 km.
- Before reaching Sarchu, we will also pass the treacherous Gata Loops that feature 21 hairpin bends at an elevation of 4669m.
- Reach Sarchu by evening, check-in to your camps and have your dinner.
- Overnight stay in Sarchu.





Day 09: Journey from Tso Moriri to Sarchu

- After breakfast, depart for Sarchu.
- Cross high passes including Nakee La, Lachung La, and Tanglang La.
- Bid farewell to the stunning beauty of Ladakh as you travel along the winding roads into Himachal Pradesh.
- Arrive in Sarchu, deposit your bike keys with the road captain, and settle in for the night.
- Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay at Swiss Camps in Sarchu.

Day 10: Journey from Sarchu to Manali

- Post breakfast in the morning, get ready for the day.
- Today, we will board our transfers to Manali via Atal Tunnel.
- On the way, we will take a quick stop at the iconic Baralacha La located at an altitude of 4850m.
- Then, we will pass the scenic Suraj Taal and Deepak Taal Lakes.
- Further, we will pass the picturesque towns of Darcha, Jispa, Keylong and Sissu until we reach the Atal Tunnel.
- After crossing the Atal Tunnel, pass through the Solang Valley - a hub for adventure activities to reach Manali.
- Upon reaching Manali, check in to your hotel and spend the evening at leisure.
- You can either rest in your room or head out to explore the Mall road where you can shop, eat or take a stroll.
- Overnight stay in Manali.





Day 11: Journey from Kullu Manali to Delhi Departure

- Wake up to a leisurely morning in Manali and have your breakfast at the hotel.
- You can then spend the day at leisure exploring Manali's charming attractions on your own.
- You can start your sightseeing by visiting the famous Hidimba Temple, dedicated to the wife of Bheem.
- Further, you can relax in the natural hot springs of Vashisht Temple which is dedicated to sage Vashisht, teacher of Lord Ram.
- After exploring various attractions, you can shop and eat around the famous Mall Road.
- By evening, reach the Manali bus stop to board your bus to Delhi.
- Overnight bus journey to Delhi.

Day 12: Arrival in Delhi

- After an overnight journey, reach Delhi in the morning.
- Your amazing Ladakh trip concludes, leaving you with a lot of adventurous memories.



INCLUSIONS:

1. Complimentary Himalayan Bike with Fuel and Helmet.
2. The package includes elbow and knee guards, as well as a helmet.
3. Stay in pre-booked Deluxe hotels on a triple sharing basis.
4. Comfy stay in Swiss Camps with attached washrooms on triple sharing.
5. Buffet Breakfast will be available from Day 2 till Day 11 and Buffet Dinner will be available from Day 1 till Day 11.
6. The Bikes will be provided from Day 2 in the morning till Day 10 in the evening.
7. Bike permits and Inner Line Permits for all travellers.
8. All Permits included.
9. Fuel will be provided as per the route mentioned in the itinerary.
10. Services of an Experienced Road Captain and Motorbike Mechanic from Day 2 in the morning till Day 10 in the evening.
11. Services of the backup seat in a vehicle for a group of more than 10 motorbikes are restricted for exigencies.
12. First Aid Medical Kit and Oxygen Cylinder at dispersal with the Road Captain.
13. Facility to carry luggage in a separate vehicle restricted to 1 Rucksack/Duffle Bag of 60 Litres per Traveller (kindly refer to the schedule of charges for additional luggage).
14. Pre-booked Luxury Semi-sleeper Volvo Seats for travellers from Delhi to Manali on Day 0 (Zero) and back to Delhi on Day 12.
15. Online Certificate on successful completion of the trip.



EXCLUSIONS:

1. Personal expenses like Telephone, Laundry, Tips, and Table Drinks, etc.
2. Any type of Insurance - Medical, Accidental, and Theft.
3. Any Airfare / Rail fare other than what is mentioned in “Inclusions”.
4. Pick-up or Drop - Airport, Railway station, or Bus Stop.
5. Cost of any spare part which will be used due to the accidental damage incurred when the motorbike is in rider's possession.
6. In case Motorbike is dropped on the way - The cost incurred to transfer/tow, vehicle servicing or maintenance cost.
7. Any lunch and other meals not mentioned in package inclusions.
8. Security deposit per motorbike of Rs. 10,000/- for accidental damages or dropping back the bike, if in case you leave the bike in between the route before the end date of the trip.
9. Parking, Monastery, and Monument entry fees during sightseeing.
10. Any cost incurred due to extension, change of itinerary due to natural calamities, road, blocks, vehicle breakdown, union issues, and factors beyond our control
11. Additional accommodation/food cost incurred due to any delay.
12. Applicable GST.
13. Anything that is not mentioned in the Inclusion sections.



NOTES

- Day 00 - The volvo will start between 6PM to 08PM as per the availability scheduled. Please make yourself available before 5 PM in Delhi at reporting point which could be Majnu Ka Tila or RK Ashram Metro Station.
- The check-in time is 12 noon/early check-in subject to availability of the room.
- We have the right to cancel the group if we do not get the minimum strength of bikes in any group.
- If there are any additional expenses due to bad weather or any other reason beyond the control of the tour operator on account of a hotel stay, transportation, and meals, etc. extra bill will be raised. Neither we or any partner associated or the participating partners/hotels will be responsible for the additional expenses.
- We are not responsible for any change in itinerary due to reasons beyond our control like change in flight and train schedule, cancellation of flights/trains, political disturbances, natural phenomenon, etc...
- If any group member wants to leave the group in-between the tour then he/she will not be eligible for any refund and has to pay the cost for transportation of bike from point of leaving the tour till the tour endpoint.
- Wearing a helmet, carrying a valid ID proof & Driving license is mandatory.
- All guests will be responsible for the safety and security of their own luggage. We will not be at all responsible for the damage / missing / lost luggage. So carry a small daypack bag to carry all the expensive things with you.
- Compensation for any damage/accident done by you during the tour to others property/person would be directly payable by you.

NOTES

- Due to any unforeseen weather conditions, road blockage, snowfall, rain, storm, the tour may continue to operate in tempo traveler instead of bikes.
- Foreign Nationals have to pay separately on their own for the permits.
- Basic First Aid Kit - It's advised that one should bring his/her own medicines which are known and suitable to him.
- Road Captain will be responsible to manage the group by taking all safety measures. The group has to follow him to make the tour a success.
- We provide a well-experienced and skilled Royal Enfield Mechanic with spare parts and tools. They are well trained to handle large groups. The spares used on the way will be chargeable.
- Backing vehicle – Bolero/Camper/Xylo/Innova/tempo for mechanical and medical support.
- In case of an emergency, if any rider is feeling uneasy then he can sit in the backup.
- Only one rucksack/backpack of 60 liters will be adjusted as it will be having tools and spares too.
